These ratings are designed to help adults identify content that may include themes, language, or scenes unsuitable for younger viewers. By reviewing these guidelines before children watch, parents and carers can ensure that viewing choices are safe, age-appropriate, and supportive of children's emotional wellbeing. This also helps children develop healthy media habits and enjoy content that is engaging, positive, and suitable for their stage of development.
